New Tenants, New Website Kick Off New Year at Shadelands

Walnut Creek, CA (January 21, 2016) – The New Year brings a vibrant new website and several new tenants to Shadelands, expanding its appeal to the surrounding community. The Orchards at Walnut Creek, Shadelands' budding town center, is currently under construction. When completed in Fall 2016, this 25-acre parcel will house Crunch Fitness, Safeway, Stein Mart, Petco, cafés, a four-acre park, one mile of walking trails and a host of exciting amenities and services that tenants, families, and neighbors will appreciate and enjoy.

The Orchards will also include a housing development on 3.8 acres called Viamonté at Walnut Creek, the area's first Continuing Care Retirement Community for dynamic seniors. It will be a collaboration from Northern California Presbyterian Homes & Services and Episcopal Senior Communities. The development will provide a maximum of 200 condo-quality residences with services and amenities to enrich the lives of the aging. It's slated to open in 2018-2019.
